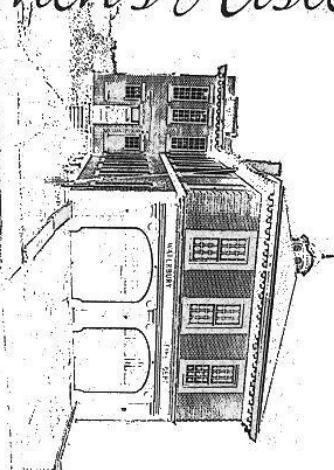

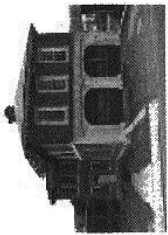

Answer The Call To Rescue The Waterville Firehouse And Put Your Name On The Path Of It's History

ERected in 1919 by Mayor Sandland's Board of Public Safety, the construction of the Waterville Firehouse coincided with the arrival of the "horseless age" in the Waterville Fire Department. It housed the old Engine 9 and a police precinct. One of three fire stations of similar design that year, it remained in service until 1971. The construction of the new and modern Northside Station spelled its demise. For the past thirty years the building has slipped into a state of disrepair.
