The Waterbury Fire Department is separated into 2 divisions: the line division consisting of those who do combat firefighting and perform emergency service responses, and the staff or support division: those who support the logistical functions of running a fire department. In addition to the fire protection and emergency response services it offers, the Waterbury Fire Department also provides special programs designed to enhance the safety of the citizens of Waterbury. These programs are implemented by the Bureau of Fire Prevention.

Fire Safety Preparedness

The Bureau of Fire Prevention, led by the Fire Marshal, serves a variety of functions to reduce the risk of fires and protect the lives of the people in our community. In addition to the Fire Marshal, the staff consists of 3 Deputy Fire Marshals, and 10 Fire Inspectors. The Bureau's responsibilities include: fire prevention through public education programs, fire investigation (determining the cause of fires), building and site inspections, and fire code enforcement.
