GUIDELINES FOR LOCAL 1339 SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Up to five (5) \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded this year;
2. This is a non-continuing scholarship. Those students awarded this scholarship are not eligible for renewal. Students who have been awarded a "Frank Sturges Memorial Scholarship" MAY APPLY for the Local 1339 Scholarship. Students who apply, but are not accepted will be eligible to re-apply;
3. These scholarships will be available to children of all active members of the Waterbury Fire Fighters Association, Local 1339, I.A.F.F. - at the time of application and to the children of members who were active at the time of their death.
4. The applicant must be a high school senior or graduate;
5. The applicant must submit a statement of intent as a full-time student by an accredited post-secondary school and name such school on form 2023-1;
6. There is no limit to the number of applicants per family. However, only one scholarship per family per year will be awarded;
7. The applicant is to complete form 2023-01 and mail it by certified mail to the Local 1339 office. It must be post marked no later than **May 31, 2023**
8. The applicant will fill in their name on form 2023-2 and give it to their counselor or advisor for completion. Form 2023-2 and an official transcript of the applicant's grades will be mailed to the Local 1339 office - post marked no later than **May 31, 2023**
9. Failure to have all forms completed and received within the time limits will result in applicant disqualification;
10. Notification of scholarship recipients will be as soon as results are received from the committee.

GUIDELINES FOR FRANK STURGES SCHOLARSHIP (next page)

1. ONE "Frank Sturges" \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded this year by the Fire Fighters Golf Classic;
2. This is a non-continuing scholarship. Those students awarded this scholarship are not eligible for renewal. Students who have been awarded a Local 1339 Scholarship MAY APPLY for the "Frank Sturges Memorial Scholarship." Students who apply, but are not accepted will be eligible to re-apply;
3. This scholarship will be available to children of all active members of the Waterbury Fire Fighters Association, Local 1339, I.A.F.F. - at the time of application and to the children of members who were active at the time of their death.
4. The applicant must be a high school senior or graduate;
5. The applicant must check the appropriate box on form 2023-1 indicating they wish to be considered for this scholarship and that their sponsor (parent), participated in one of the previous year's Golf Tournaments
6. The applicant must submit a statement of intent as a full-time student by an accredited post-secondary school and name such school on form 2023-1;
7. There is no limit to the number of applicants per family. However, only one scholarship per family per year will be awarded;
8. The applicant is to complete form 2023-1 and mail it by certified mail to the Local 1339 office. It must be post marked no later than **May 31, 2023**
9. The applicant will fill in their name on form 2023-2 and give it to their counselor or advisor for completion. Form 2023-2 and an official transcript of the applicant's grades will be mailed to the Local 1339 office - post marked no later than **May 31, 2023**.
